



COVID-19 PROTECTIVE MEASURES

Trans-Northern Pipelines Inc. (TNPI) is committed to fostering a positive, safe and healthy work environment for all employees, clients, and sub-contractors.

When working on landowner property or within their premises, TNPI will ensure that its employees or contractors diligently follow guidelines developed specifically for COVID-19.

Below are the **multi-level pandemic mitigation measures** you can expect to be followed by our employees and contractors to help protect your health, and theirs:

- All employees and contractors must complete a **self-assessment** to screen for symptoms of COVID-19 and ensure they are fit for duty prior to reporting to a work site.
- All workers must practice **physical distancing** of 2 metres (6 feet), and restrict group interactions and the congregation of groups.
- **Respiratory protection** (a facial mask) is required when they are inside the home of a landowner or working in their vicinity.
- Workers are expected to **follow cough/sneeze etiquette**, which is a combination of measures that minimizes the transmission of diseases via droplet or airborne routes. Cough/sneeze etiquette includes the following:
 - Cover mouth and nose with a sleeve or tissue when coughing or sneezing
 - Use tissues to contain secretions and dispose of them promptly in a waste container outside of the residence.
 - Turn head away from others when coughing or sneezing.
 - Wash hands with soap regularly.
- If applicable, the proper **cleaning and disinfecting** of all surfaces a worker has come into contact with to complete their work inside your premises will be performed before departure .
