Dear Pipeline Neighbour,

Please find enclosed our latest TNPI Info newsletter, containing important information and updates about Trans-Northern's commitment to keeping our pipeline neighbours such as you, the public, and the environment safe.

Pipeline safety is a shared responsibility. You can help avoid incidents by following these safe practices:

- **Watch and report** unusual smells, vandalism, broken marker signs and/or other damage by calling **1-800-361-0608** or, for non-emergency notices, by emailing us at info@tnpi.ca
- **Always "click" before you dig.** Regulations require that you contact Utility Safety Partners (previously known as Alberta One-Call) before commencing any digging within 30 metres of each side of a pipeline, any construction near the pipeline, or if crossing over a pipeline with a vehicle or machinery.
- **Report immediately** any contact made with the pipeline or damage caused to the pipeline by calling us at **1-800-361-0608** (even a nick to the pipe can lead to corrosive, long-term damage).
